Pathfinders Nature Mentoring is offering nature connection summer camps for elementary school students this summer.

The campers travel in the Pathfinders' vans to visit local preserves Foothills Park, Windy Hill, Huddart Park, Castle Rock State Park and San Gregorio State Beach. They will explore tracking, nature awareness games, nature music, storytelling, river rock paints, bow drill fire making, wild edibles, primitive shelter making and more.
